1. Article should be an original and unpublished work about relevant issues concerning ASEAN or the Southeast Asian region.
2. In submitting articles for publication, you grant The Habibie Center ASEAN Studies Program the right to edit and publish the content in this website and associated electronic print publications and to archive the contents for possible republication.
3. The recommended word count is between 900 – 1.200.
4. We recommend that the article is written using Times New Roman 12 and 1.5 spaces.
5. We only accept submission that uses the .doc or .docx format.
6. Citation or bibliography should use *American Psychological Association* style. Please find below, a brief example:

(a) Reference within the text should provide the author's name and year of publication between brackets,

e.g.

(Habibie 2008)

(b) The bibliography should be arranged alphabetically, and written as follows: Last name, first name. (year). Book title. City: Publisher.

e.g.:

Habibie, BJ. (2008). *Detik-Detik yang Menentukan: Jalan Panjang Indonesia Menuju Demokrasi*. Jakarta: THC Mandiri.
